

Consent & Ownership of Embryos

- Who legally owns the embryos?

- Can I specify how embryos should be used or disposed of in the future?



Storage & Handling of Embryos

- What are the clinic's policies and procedures for storing embryos?
- How long can embryos be stored, and what happens if I stop paying storage fees?
- What safeguards are in place to prevent mixups or loss of embryos?



Surrogacy & Third-Party Reproduction

- What legal agreements are required for using a surrogate, sperm donor, or egg donor?
- Does the clinic help facilitate contracts with donors and surrogates, or do I need an attorney?
- How does the clinic ensure donor and surrogate rights are legally protected?



Genetic Testing & Reporting

- What genetic tests are performed on embryos before implantation?
- What happens if an embryo is found to have a genetic disorder?
- Can I request that my embryos be used only for specific medical conditions or preferences?
